






Project Headlines



- Small run of the river hydro scheme 425 Kw
- On land leased from Forestry Commission Scotland
- Income via FIT's and on wholesale power market
- Donating all the profit to CCDT
- Scheme completed Sept 2014
- Completed on time within budget (£1.7 M)
- Borrowed £2.1 M pay down expensive debt
- £1.23 Million turnover since commissioning




Map of Catchment Area 4.23km²








Stank Burn Vertical Profile


Control System Schematic




